


Flowchem VE GL (2-3 mm)

Note: Add Flowchem VE Topcoat Additive to the final topcoat only at 1.5% by weight of Resin. The Flowchem VE topcoat resins normally give a glossy finish. When the Flowchem VE Topcoat Additive is used, the resultant finish is a satin matte. Non-slip finishes: Various grades of quartz can be incorporated to provide a textured surface.

NB: Specifications are written for each installation to meet the clients particular requirements.

Substrate Requirements

Reinforced concrete substrates should be capable of producing 1.5 N/mm² "pull-off" values and, following preparation, be free from laitance, dust and other contamination. The substrate should be visibly dry with a moisture content not exceeding 75% RH as per BS8203 (4.5% on Tramex scale), and free from rising damp and ground water pressure.

Installation Service

The installation should be carried out by a CPG approved contractor with a documented quality assurance scheme. Obtain details of our approved contractors by contacting our customer service team or enquiring via our website www.flowcrete.eu.

Aftercare, Cleaning & Maintenance

Clean floors regularly using a single or double headed rotary scrubber drier in conjunction with a mildly alkaline detergent.
